It hosted and help launch some of Scotland's greatest musical exports, with the likes of **Frightened Rabbit**, **Twin Atlantic**, **Twilight Sad**, **Admiral Fallow**, **Young Fathers** and more all making early and pivotal appearances. It even managed to upset everyone from UKIP to the **Catholic Church**.

Now amidst the Covid19 pandemic and the crisis facing the hospitality industry across the globe, the bar continues to survive, promoting charity causes, advocating for young musicians and taking pride as part of a vibrant local community.
